| 12 | Cooking jug | 108 | 1022.28 | Brown-red clay, gray core, large and small white inclusions |
| 13 | Juglet | 109 | 1036.3 | Hemispherical body; black clay; burnish marks on body |

| 2 | Bowl base | 103 | 1001.6 | Well-levigated pinkish clay; thick red slip; incisions on int. |
| 3 | Cooking pot | 109 | 1029.14 | Brown-red clay, gray core, small white inclusions; soot on rim |
| 4 | Cooking pot | 105 | 1016.11 | Brown-red clay; soot on body |
| 5 | Cooking pot | 102 | 1008 | Brown-red clay; soot on rim |
| 6 | Cooking pot | 102 | 1008.4 | Red core; completely covered with black soot |
| 7 | Cooking pot | 102 | 1008.2 | Brown-red clay; thin groove on rim; no soot |
| 8 | Cooking pot | 108 | 1022.17 | Brown-red clay; soot on handle |
| 9 | Jar | 105 | 1016.9 | Yellow-pinkish clay, gray core, small white inclusions |
| 10 | Jar | 102 | 1001.13 | Gray clay, pink core; remains of light-colored slip |
| 11 | Jar | 105 | 1016.15 | Light brown clay, few white inclusions |
| 12 | Jar | 102 | 1001.14 | Light orange clay; remains of light-colored slip on neck's int., remains of unsmoothed material on neck's ext. |
| 13 | Jar | 102 | 1001.4 | Light brown clay, thin gray core |
| 14 | Jar | 100 | 100.1 | Fragment; light brown clay; dark brown painted strip |
| 15 | Bottle | 109 | 1029.13 | Light orange clay, small white inclusions; white slip on ext. |
| 16 | Jug | 105 | 1016.10 | Brown-yellowish clay, few white inclusions |
| 17 | Jug | 102 | 1008.3 | Light brown clay; the vessel is not fully smoothed on both the int. and ext. |
| 18 | Jug | 102 | 1001.7 | Pink int. and Yellowish ext., small white inclusions in section |
| 19 | Juglet | 102 | 1001.11 | Light pink clay, few inclusions |
| 20 | Jar handle | 108 | 1022.9 | Light orange clay, white inclusions; two vertical depressions on the handle |
| 21 | Flask handle | 102 | 1001.10 | Gray clay; the handle is turned from the neck toward the body |
| 22 | Lamp | 102 | 1004 | The filling hole; light brown clay, white inclusions; parring marks on body |
| 23 | Stone vessel | 105 | 1016 | Rim of chalk vessel |
