3	Bottle	113	1054	Rim 48	Light bluish green glass; yellow patches of weathering, iridescence and pitting
4	Bottle	121	1086	Rim 48	Light greenish glass; silver weathering, iridescence and sand deposits
5	Bottle	103	1030/2	Rim 122	Light bluish green glass; milky silver weathering, iridescence and pitting
