6	Jar	101	1013	Brown-gray clay, fired to a buff hue, with few large white inclusions
7	Jar	100	1000	Clay fired to a cream hue with few large white inclusions
8	Jar	101	1007	Brown-red clay, fired to an orange hue, with white and brown inclusions
9	Jar	122	1022	Brown clay with white inclusions
10	Jar	102	1011	Gray clay with numerous white inclusions of various sizes
11	Amphoriskos	100	1000	Buff clay with many black and brown inclusions
12	Jug	102	1002	Buff clay with white inclusions
13	Sphero-conical container	121	1033	Levigated and hard-fired brown-gray clay
14	Sphero-conical container	124	1031	Levigated and hard-fired brown clay with gray core and large, white inclusions
15	Jar lid	100	1000	Buff clay with small black inclusions
16	Flask	121	1019	Buff clay with white and black inclusions
